Discussion Group



We want to invite you to celebrate Advent with us at FOCUS!

What is Advent? The word advent itself means "arrival" or "an appearing or coming into place."

The Advent season lasts for four Sundays. It begins on the fourth Sunday before Christmas, or the nearest Sunday to November 30, this year it is November 29. Advent then ends on Christmas Eve.

The Advent celebration is both a commemoration of Christ's first coming and an anticipation of His second coming. As Israel

longed for their Messiah to come, so Christians long for their Savior to come again. At FOCUS, we celebrate Christ's first coming by using an Advent Wreath, each week lighting a new candle. Each of the candles represents one of
