Sunday Evening Prayer and Study gathering 6:30-8PM

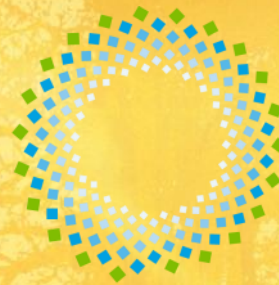

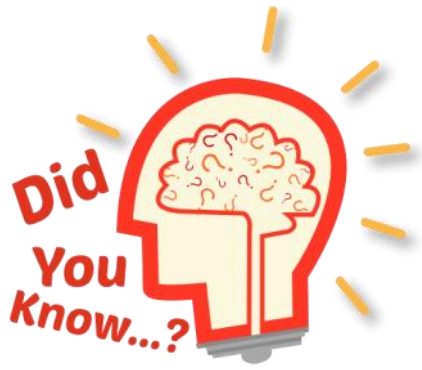
