

Hurricane Harvey Response

Update *Your help is still needed to aid victims of Hurricane Harvey. Read how you can help in tangible ways.*

Wesleyan churches continue to commit finances, supplies and workers to assist in hurricane relief and recovery efforts. Recently joining efforts are New Life, La Plata, Maryland, Christ Wesleyan, Milton, Pennsylvania, and Cornerstone Community (CCC), Charlottesville, Virginia. CCC donated its entire Sunday offer to relief efforts.

“World Hope and Poured Out personnel are on the ground in Texas,” said John Lyon, World Hope International president. Poured Out Executive Director Steve Adams participated in a response call with William Long, FEMA (Federal Emergency Management Association) administrator, during which Long wept while describing the destruction. Long said there will likely be over one million homes flooded, which will make Hurricane Harvey worse than Hurricane Katrina.

“Long also said there aren’t many recovery groups like World Hope at the table at the moment,” Lyon said. “He referenced that help is primarily coming from first responders that come early and leave early, acknowledging there are not many organizations like World Hope that are willing to come and stay for the long haul.”

Lyon is engaged in an aid and disaster preparedness conference. World Hope is joining other charities that respond to disasters. This partnership will allow World Hope and its partners to leverage even more supplies and logistics to places where they can be distributed, namely Wesleyan churches.

“These connections will allow The Wesleyan Church to stand out if Irma strikes Florida or anywhere else on the southeast coast,” Lyon said. “If Irma hits, we are ready to respond.”
